SENATOR CUDABACK: There's been a request for a call of the house. All those in favor of the house going under call please vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 23 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, to place the house under call.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The house is under call. All unexcused (sic--unauthorized) personnel please leave the floor. All unexcused senators please report to the Chamber, then check in. The house is under call. All unexcused (sic) personnel please leave the floor. Unexcused senators please check in. The house is under call. Unexcused senators please check in. Senator Baker, Senator Dwite Pedersen. Senator Robak, please check in, please. We are looking for Senator Robak. Go ahead, go ahead. All present or accounted for, the question before the body is, shall the Chambers amendment be adopted to the committee amendments of LB 120? All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted who care to? There's been a request for a roll call vote. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken, Legislative Journal page 422.) 19 ayes, 28 nays, Mr. President, on the amendment.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The Chambers amendment to the committee amendments of LB 120 is not adopted. I raise the call. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, a priority motion. Senator Chambers would move to reconsider that vote just taken.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Chambers, on your reconsideration motion.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you, Mr. President. I think that the supporters of this bill should start rounding up their 33 votes. Senator Brashear has made it clear that on Senator Crosby's bill he has dug his heels in. Well, I've dug mine in, too. And a bill such as this is going to enter the statute books only after 24 hours of serious discussion. And my debate on this bill is
