SENATOR CUDABACK: Report is adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Schrock, as Chair of Natural Resources, reports on the appointments of Randall Stinnette and Marvin Westcott to the Game and Parks Commission.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Schrock.

SENATOR SCHROCK: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, the Natural Resources Committee held a hearing on January 20th for the purpose of confirming Randall Stinnette to the Game and Parks Commission, and Marvin Westcott to the Game and Parks Commission. Randall Stinnette was ill, but he was represented by Rex Amack, who answered questions and commented on Randall Stinnette. He's from Inland, Nebraska. He does fulfill one of the requirements that two of those positions have to be filled by a farmer or a rancher. He's been involved in wildlife associations. He has served on the Game and Parks Commission before. Marvin Westcott is an individual from Holdrege, Nebraska. I know him well. He's very qualified, very knowledgeable about hunting and wildlife issues. So, with that, the committee did vote. The vote was 6 affirmative and 2...2 members absent. I would recommend to the Legislature that Marvin Westcott and Randall Stinnette be confirmed as appointees to the Game and Parks Commission.
