way that we thought would really simplify this bill. So this amendment reads that: All children under the age of five and weighing less than forty pounds must be restrained in a child seat. That's in Section...subsection (a) of the amendment, line 8. And then the other change was: All children under the age of five weighing more than forty pounds can be in adult restraining seat belts. That is the change, makes it easier to enforce, much easier to understand, and it does conform with various other states. That was the other question that I needed to answer from General File was the committee amendment did change this thing to include people in Nebraska; not just Nebraska residents, but anyone driving through Nebraska. So I need to bring that up. That is on the handout that was distributed. All the surrounding states have child restraint laws on the books. They vary, they are all over the place, Kansas, for instance, three years and younger and then four through thirteen; Colorado, three and younger, and there is some forty pound restrictions. It's...forty pounds seems to be pretty standard as a breaking line there, but everyone involved, all the states who surround us do have child seat restraint laws, fairly similar, so we are not going to set a potential trap for anyone driving into Nebraska from out of state and be able to fine them. So, that is my amendment. Thank you.
