SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. Speaker and members of the Legislature, Senator Thompson and I have had a number of discussions about this bill, I mean her amendment, and I agreed to go along with the two amendments that she is offering. The second one will make it a secondary offense. If she hadn't been willing, and she already had the amendment drafted, by the way, so it took away what I was going to do in terms of just opposing anything being added to the bill. But I'd like to ask my good friend, Senator Byars, the passionate one, a question.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Byars, would you respond?

SENATOR BYARS: Certainly will to my gray-haired colleague.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Senator Byars, you nor anybody else, to my knowledge, and this is not a criticism, in a way it is just asking the question, why do we not require seat belts on school buses and school vans? Is it that we fear to deal with the dealers and the manufacturers; our concern for children stops when we have to deal with big interests? So here's the question, why do we not require seat belts to be worn by children on school buses and in school vans?

SENATOR BYARS: Senator Chambers, I would be very happy to introduce such legislation, would be happy to have you as my cosponsor.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Well, I'll tell you...thank you, that's all I was asking. Something like that would go much better with me than some of the other things we've done, and the reason I don't want this particular one to be a primary offense is for the same reasons I didn't want the other.
