CLERK: I have nothing further on LB 658, Mr. President.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Smith, you're recognized for a motion to advance.

SENATOR SMITH: Mr. Speaker, I move the advancement of LB 658 to E & R for engrossing.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: The question before the body is the advancement of LB 658. All those in favor say aye. Those opposed say nay. It is advanced. We next move to LB 289.

CLERK: LB 289, Senator, I do have Enrollment and Review amendments, first of all. (AM7175, Legislative Journal page 399.)

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Smith, you're recognized for a motion to adopt those E & R amendments.

SENATOR SMITH: Mr. Speaker, I move the adoption of the E & R amendments to LB 289.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: The question before the body...Senator Landis, would you care to debate?

SENATOR LANDIS: No, on the bill.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: On the bill. Thank you. The question before the body is the adoption of the E & R amendments. All those in favor say aye. Those opposed say nay. They are adopted.

CLERK: Senator Beutler would move to amend. (AM2075, Legislative Journal page 364.)

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Beutler, you're recognized to open on your amendment.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Senator Kristensen, members of the Legislature, this is a clarifying amendment which I think is agreeable to Senator Cudaback because it does not conflict with his original intent and it merely says this, failure to
