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amount of time and I'm willing to take it, and I hope you all are willing to take it with me. My motion is to bracket this bill. We'll bracket or have racket, and either way is all right with me because I'm going to be here 60 days anyway, so what difference does it make to me what I talk about. But at least the subject I've chosen to discuss on this bill is one that I think has considerable substance. And who knows, maybe the transcript will even be taken and used by people who want to show some of the background of why there is such problems, there are such problems in Ireland today. You know another thing they did...how much time do I have, Mr. President?

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: Two minutes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: I might can get this in just by way of introduction. You know what they would do as far as...see, there was in the 700 years before the Great Famine, there were...there was a succession of invaders and oppressors in Ireland and Henry...William of Orange was a rabid anti-Catholic. So when the penal laws came into effect, and I'll give the dates as I go into more detail but I'm just trying to give an overview, Catholics couldn't own land. They couldn't buy land, and if they had...if they owned it at the time, when one died, it was divided equally among all the sons in the family. So there would be little bitty pieces of land. But if the eldest son would convert to Protestantism, then he could keep the entire estate. In a period of 50 to 60 years, one piece of land which was owned by one person came under tenancy of about three score, which is 60. That is my motion and I intend to go to the wall on this one.

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: Senator Chambers, your light is next.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you, Mr. President. When I'm involved in an effort, I like to have my ducks lined up. So I wanted to be sure that my light was on so I can continue. I have a handout I'm going to send you all, and you will see something crossed out in the middle. What is crossed out is a comment addressing concern that Joe Steele had expressed of a general nature on the bill. Attached to this that I'm handing out is a copy of a letter that Joe Steele sent to me to show that...I'm going to read what he said, but I want you to have the whole
