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SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay, so then the committee amendment is amenable to division based on the part of the bill that each one of those amendments would address in the bill, would you agree?

SENATOR BRASHEAR: I certainly wouldn't want to invade the discretion of the Chair but I would think so.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: And I think like 2 and 3, you know, those two might go together, so I'm going to divide the question. And I wanted to say it on the mike so that you could be alerted and you can come forth to help and, naturally, Senator Hilgert. And whichever parts of the committee amendment should be taken as one entity, we will do that. So at this time, Mr. President, Mr. President, may we approach who are interested in dividing the question so we can be sure that we're getting stand alone pieces of it.

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: Yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay, thank you.

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: All right, the question is divisible. The question will be divided with the language on line 1, which is, strike Section 1, is division number one. Division number two will be lines 2 through 9, which are Sections 2 and 3 of the proposed amendment. Division three will be lines 10 and 11, which is Sections 4 and 5 of the proposed amendment. Senator Brashear, would you like to refresh our memories as to the effect of the first division, which is Section 1 of the amendment.

SENATOR BRASHEAR: Yes, Mr. President, thank you. Members of the body, committee amendment, the committee amendment in the first division strikes Section 1 of the green copy in the entirety, therefore, not permitting any increase in the amount that a landlord can require of a tenant by reason of the tenant having need of the services of a guide dog. I can't think of any way to elaborate on that.

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: Thank you for that statement. Senator Chambers, you'd be recognized to speak to the first division of
