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the committee amendments, that being Section 1 of the amendment to strike Section 1 of the original bill.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you. Mr. President, I would like to ask Senator Hilgert a question, if I may.

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: Senator Hilgert, will you yield?

SENATOR HILGERT: Certainly, on your time, Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Yes, Senator Hilgert, did you draft this bill?

SENATOR HILGERT: No, was not and, frankly, I was certainly part of the committee which made the committee amendment to strike Section 1, I thought that should go away.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Senator Hilgert, who drafted this bill, if you know?

SENATOR HILGERT: I don't remember, Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Who brought you the bill to introduce?

SENATOR HILGERT: Well, there were some interested parties, Frank Kucirek (phonetic). There was Tom McNally.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Do you believe they drafted the bill?

SENATOR HILGERT: And I think they had advice and counsel.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Who gave them advice if you know?

SENATOR HILGERT: I am not sure, I can't speak that they actually did it, but I believe that they did have advice and counsel of the industry's representative, Mr. Radcliffe, and others probably. I am not sure. I can't speak what they did or didn't do,...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Who thought...oh, excuse me.

SENATOR HILGERT: ...but I was approached by those individuals.
