SENATOR HILGERT: I would, if we had something before us at this time to do away with the entire amendment, I would listen to both sides, but I think that you have an argument there, Senator.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you, Senator. That's all that I have with you at this point. This bill is going to be before us for a long time because there are things, to be quite frank with you, in the current law that I think are inappropriate, and I think whenever we have a person who suffers from a disability and the federal law...

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: Time. Senator Hilgert.

SENATOR HILGERT: Thank you, Mr. President and members. I just wanted to briefly say, which I already got on record, that I support the first section of the divided question, which is striking references to Section 1. Thank you very much.

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: Thank you. Senator Bourne.

SENATOR BOURNE: Thank you, Mr. President. I did vote for the bracket motion simply because I don't believe there is anything in this bill that would really justify going actually 24 hours debate on that. However, I did support the bill coming out of committee as amended because I think that the committee amendments soften the impact of the original bill. I do have some concerns about Senator Quandahl's amendment. I think that to go from as it is now, ten days notice, to five days to three days, I think that's a little extreme. I don't think we're giving enough notice to the tenants in this situation. I do have an amendment that should be coming up pretty soon that takes the...yeah, maybe next week as Senator Hilgert indicated, but the original bill calls for a two month's security deposit, and I have an amendment that would move that back to one month's security deposit. I think that's a more reasonable alternative. Again, I did support the committee amendments. I did support the bill, but I do have some concern. Thank you.
