"General" Stenberg; and if the ship sinks, I'm going down with the ship, with "Rear Admiral" Stenberg. And there (laugh) were others who said the same thing. But once the ship N.N. Bob Kerrey was not going to engage in battle, people started jumping off that ship. And not only did some jump off, some manned a ship of their own and trained their cannons on the N.N. Stenberg, Nebraska Navy Stenberg, N.N.S., I guess, Nebraska Naval Ship Stenberg and blasted holes in it. And as a result of that, brothers and sisters, I am compelled to do something I thought I would never do. I have listed myself as the "Defender of the Downtrodden". I did not draw any lines or allow of any exceptions, it was just a blanket declaration. Well now "General" Stenberg, a.k.a. "Rear Admiral" Stenberg, has now been placed unceremoniously among the ranks of the downtrodden. So I must now defend "General-Rear Admiral" Stenberg. Brothers and sisters, I would like to say a few words in behalf of "General" Stenberg. Thank you. Now back to my discussion of this bill. I had stated last week that I see this as a situation where lobbyist Walt Radcliffe has determined that he's going to show the strength that he has. The thing is that Mr. Radcliffe is not on this floor and I am, and I will continue to be on this floor. He said this is just another bill to him, but it has become more than that to those whose names are on it; it is a crusade. And when people are on crusades there is no swaying them, there is no turning them to the right or to the left. So, in no case do I expect those whose names are on this bill to declare, as Mr. Radcliffe did, it's just another bill. That is another one of the vagaries of politics. People will get themselves placed in a position where they're giving more of themselves to a notion than the one who brought it to them initially. The one who brought it keeps his options open, is able to withdraw whenever he chooses and protect his other interests, bigger fish which he hopes will not join the fish fry. But those who have jumped out there relying on him have now taken a step and crossed a line, and they cannot retreat; they've got to carry it right to the gate, right to the wall, and I'm going to help them do it. And what this will demonstrate is not only my willingness to deliver on promises that I make,...
