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Dictionary, a Webster's Collegiate Dictionary, first, second, third, fourth edition, but Webster is a name renowned for dictionaries and in this country has become synonymous. Webster's Dictionary spells the word that pronounced in two ways, l-a-r-g-e-s-s or l-a-r-g-e-s-s-e, and the preferred pronunciation is "lar-jess" in America. Now I don't know where Senator Tyson feels his first loyalty goes. I don't know what he does on Decoration Day. I don't know whether he flies Old Glory or the Union Jack, but his particular political preferences are his. But when it comes to the pronunciation of American English the word is pronounced "lar-jess", l-a-r-j-e-s-s, not "lar-jeece" or however he would pronounce it. "Baron" Tyson, on this floor, English is spoken here, American English, although Senator Tyson does stray into Latin every now and then. And on that point, because I will digress, there are some people who want to make it possible or mandatory that English be deemed what's called the official language, and only English is to be spoken. There are some companies where people who speak a different language, notably Spanish, have been fired because during their break they speak to each other in Spanish. And the people who only know English, who are deficient in their education feel set upon and made to feel inferior because they know only one language to speak, and they think, in their paranoia, that people speaking a different language may be speaking disparagingly of them. But had they not wronged anybody, what reason would they have to think that somebody is speaking ill of them? Senator...

SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Senator Cudaback, there was a time when I wouldn't even go to a football game because I was very self-conscious and I thought everybody was laughing at me. And when I went to a football game and saw them in a huddle, I thought they were down there in the huddle laughing at me. It can get pretty bad. That's a joke, that's a joke, I don't even go to football games. But some people do have it that bad. But if Latin can be spoken on this floor, if Spanish occasionally, a word or two can be spoken on this floor, then we should not do certain things in terms of banning the use of other language, we should improve our education so that we know how to speak more than one language.
