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tested. Now could this...could that happen? Could that happen and then you would be held by the police for something that, you know, that it wasn't your fault, that the prescription was doing this? Could that happen?

SENATOR DW. PEDERSEN: Yes, that could happen as the way I...the way I read the bill, and it should have...probably noticed that before but, yes, the way I read it I believe it could happen.

SENATOR JANSSEN: Because it says drugs, well, you know, prescription drugs, illegal drugs, whatever it would be. I'm concerned about that...I don't, you know, this is the first time I've looked at the bill, Senator, and if there were some way that that could be fixed, why that would sure make me feel a lot better with the bill. But the way it is now, if this was going to happen, you are going to have some people who intentionally did not...did not do this. They didn't do it intentionally and they are going to suffer the consequences of this and have to jump through a lot of hoops that they shouldn't have to if they are under a doctor's care and they are taking prescription medication. Would you agree to that?

SENATOR DW. PEDERSEN: I would agree.

SENATOR JANSSEN: Okay, but that's all. You know I know we do a lot of things here that we think are of no consequences but that is why we have discussion on the floor to try to avoid any pitfalls that may be out there for the general public, and Senator Pedersen has a good idea, I'd like to support the bill, but unless we can get that...get a provision in the bill that excludes prescription medication or...to that effect, I mean sometimes you can even take too many Anacin or aspirins or some of the cold tablets have a lot of...high concentration of a certain chemical that does not work good with any alcohol of any amount. So I'm just trying to warn everyone that these things could happen and I think Senator Pedersen will probably address this issue. Thank you.

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you, Senator Janssen. Senator Bromm.

SENATOR BROMM: Thank you, Senator Crosby, and this...this discussion needs to be...needs to be held. We need to have this
