take on that. Senator Beutler, could I ask you a like question.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Beutler, do you yield?

SENATOR BEUTLER: Sure.

SENATOR VRTISKA: The question I asked Senator Chambers, do you think that this should ought to follow through because of the...and Ernie gave a reason why he didn't think so. I just wondered what your reason or do you have a reason why county attorneys shouldn't. Because we're talking about enforcement of the law, do you think they ought to be on a nonpartisan basis?

SENATOR BEUTLER: I haven't...I haven't really focused on the...

SENATOR VRTISKA: Okay.

SENATOR BEUTLER: ...on the county attorneys, Senator, but the Attorney General, in my mind, is very much different in the sense that the Attorney General has the huge responsibility of giving opinions to all agencies of state agencies, so there's some difference there I think, but...

SENATOR VRTISKA: Okay. All right, I appreciate that. Well, again, as I indicated when I opened that I did vote to bring this on the floor simply because it would have some good debate and we would then, at that time, make up our mind. I just wanted to make my position clear I was never very much in support of the idea when it came out, but I thought giving everybody a chance to have their voice on it, because it's an important issue, at least in the minds of many, and at this point I'm not sure that I am totally convinced that it's a good idea for some of the reasons that have been already expressed by those who oppose this legislation. On the other hand, I'd told Ernie, when I talked to him a minute ago, that he's going to have to do a better job of selling me if he expected me to vote for this bill, and there again it's been brought out before it's everybody's...certainly their own choice. But I do have some problems in some ways that have been already alluded to, and I'm not going to repeat those because all of you have heard some of the testimony, but I'm going to sit back and at least I think there's another speaker or two...
