Continuity on the board will benefit from this change. With that, Mr. President, I would conclude my remarks.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you. As Chairperson of the Government and Military Affairs Committee, you are recognized to open on the committee amendments. (AM0711, Legislative Journal page 875, First Session, 1999.)

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Okay, thank you, Mr. President and members of the body. Because of the "prepassage" of LB 113, we need to correct some of the provisions of the committee amendment that was passed out of committee last year and some of those sections are: We would omit Section 1 and Section 2, we would retain Section 3, and we would remove Sections 4 and 5. We need to go ahead and pass the actual amendment so that then we can make the elimination of these sections.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Schimek.

CLERK: Senator, I now have pending...I now have in front of me AM2123, which is an amendment to the committee amendments. (AM2123, Legislative Journal page 471.)

SENATOR SCHIMEK: That is correct. Thank you, Mr. Clerk, and that is the amendment that takes out those sections from the committee amendment that already were taken care of last year in LB 113, and just renumbers the remaining part of that amendment. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Schimek. We are now on the amendment to the committee amendments. It is AM2123. Those wishing to speak to that amendment? Senator Wehrbein.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Mr. President, members of the body, Senator Schimek, I'd like to ask a question. The handout that you have says LB 654, department cleanup bill. Is this the way the amendment stands now?
