SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Schimek. The question before the body is, shall AM2123 be adopted to the committee amendments to LB 654? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of the amendment to the committee amendments.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The amendment is adopted.

CLERK: Senator, just so you and I are in sync, the other amendments I have are to the bill. Okay. Okay.

SENATOR CUDABACK: We are back now to the committee amendments. There are no lights on, Senator Schimek. Did you wish to...we are now on the committee amendments. She waives closing on the committee amendments, so the question now before the body is, shall the committee amendments be adopted to LB 654? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted who care to? Record, Mr. Clerk.
