SENATOR JANSSEN: Right.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Thank you.

SENATOR JANSSEN: That's what I thought. Thank you, Senator Schimek, and thank you, Senator Wehrbein, for the time.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Janssen and Senator Wehrbein. Discussing the amendment to LB 654. Senator Schimek, there are no further lights. Would you like to close on your amendment?

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Yes, I just would like to note that this removes the sunset of July 1st, year 2000, and extends it on for employee...benefits for temporary employees. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Schimek. The question before the body is, shall AM2118 be adopted to LB 654? All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted who care to? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 29 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Schimek's amendment.

SENATOR CUDABACK: AM2118 is adopted.

CLERK: Senator Schimek would move to amend with AM2159. (AM2159, Legislative Journal page 471.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Schimek, to open on your amendment.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Yes, thank you, Mr. President, members of the body. This actually is a bill that was introduced, LB 934, was introduced and had a hearing date on January 21st of this year. There were...there were 7 votes in favor of advancement, none against and 1 person absent. The only people who really came in to testify on this was the Department of Administrative Services in favor of. Again, it is provisions that the department feels that it needs, and if you'll follow along with me on the second handout sheet, and it says AM2159 at the top of it, LB 934, and
