PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Janssen. The question is, shall AM2159 be adopted? Those in favor vote aye, those opposed nay. Mr. Clerk, please record.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Schimek's amendment.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The amendment is agreed to.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Debate on the advancement of LB 654? Senator Janssen, you're recognized to close. Senator Janssen waives closing. The question is the advancement of LB 654 to E & R Initial. Those in favor vote aye, those opposed nay. Please record.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of LB 654.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The bill is advanced. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 654A, a bill by Senator Schimek. (Read title.) I do have amendments to the bill, Mr. President. (AM2124, Legislative Journal page 424.)

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Senator Janssen, to open on LB 654A.

SENATOR JANSSEN: Thank you, Mr. Lieutenant Governor, members of the Legislature. This amendment, actually what it does, it strikes the language from...that was passed last year and puts into place a function whereby the Task Force for Building Renewal, that money can be transferred over into another...into another section so that it can be accessed by DAS. The money still goes, \$3,010,000 from the state Building Renewal Assessment Fund and it gets transferred over, still goes to the same place. It still is in the same place it goes through. I have charts here to show people that...where it goes, but it's the same situation. It's a procedural matter and, there again,
