SENATOR TYSON: Mr. Lieutenant Governor, I think that Senator Schrock has really...this is not a...complex or complicated bill. I think that Senator Schrock has covered it very well. I have my light on. The only purpose of me having my light on was to ask for your support. This is a dead, simple bill and, as Senator Schrock has so rightly pointed out, there is still controversy about the Cowboy Trail. If you ever elect me "King of Nebraska", which is not likely, I would make some changes there, but that's not the case. The controversy will continue, but the fence will be taken care of and I think just having the fence is the important thing. Thank you.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator.

SENATOR TYSON: And I'm going to turn my light off.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Tyson. (Visitors introduced.) Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Senator Schrock would move to amend the committee amendments, AM1990. (AM1990, Legislative Journal page 171.)

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Schrock, recognized to open on your amendment to the committee amendments.

SENATOR SCHROCK: Mr. Lieutenant Governor, the amendment that I am proposing redefines the committee amendment and I did explain that, so it's part of the committee amendment. Really, what it says, a landowner must file a request, and the cost-share of the division fence shall not exceed the amount of money that is available from Game and Parks. So it's nothing new. It's just...it was part of the committee amendment to clarify some issues and was agreed to by the committee.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Schrock. On the Schrock amendment, Senator Coordsen

SENATOR COORDSEN: Thank you, Mr. President, members of the body. The trail on the Old Chicago Northwestern line is a fact. This Legislature did adopt that, take possession, and the responsibility of the Game and Parks Commission to oversee the development in that trail, as the Legislature had envisioned, is
