other kinds of animals in a world today where almost all the kinds of animals that are raised are raised in confined operations. What...let's go back to the two points from which this can be discussed and move to how the compromise was reached. Under railroad fencing law, which is the law that would apply if the railroad were there, the railroad would be obligated to both build the fence and to maintain it, and that was put into place because of the dangers to farmers--animals running on to the rails and being killed, frankly. Coming at the...

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: One minute.

SENATOR BEUTLER: ...law from the other side, if it were not a railroad but you had two different landowners, how would that be treated? Well, in that case, both the construction and the maintenance is equally divided between the landowners. So you can see there are two completely different systems. As between those two systems, how have state parks previously been treated? And don't forget this is...the trail is a state park. It's a state recreational trail. Under that law, the law of two different landowners applied. In other words, Game and Parks would be responsible for half the construction and half the maintenance, just as if there were two different landowners; Game and Parks was substituted for one of the two landowners.
