Schrock, you're recognized to close on the amendment to the committee amendments.

SENATOR SCHROCK: Mr. Lieutenant Governor, members of the Legislature, I understand there's \$50,000 available to build fence in the fencing fund right now, so this isn't something that Game and Parks has said, well, you can pass the bill but there's no money available, we won't build fence. Game and Parks is willing to build fence as money is available, and there...and there is going to be money available. That doesn't mean it's all going to get built at once. And there's a lot of good fence out there now that doesn't need to be replaced. And this is an agreement. If you want a fence built you have to have a written request, and Game and Parks can build them as the funds are available. Shouldn't be a very difficult amendment. I would appreciate your support.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Schrock. The question is the adoption of the Schrock amendment to the committee amendments to LB 701. Those in favor vote aye, those opposed nay. Voting on the Schrock amendment. Please record.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Schrock's amendment.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The amendment is agreed to. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Senator Coordsen would move to amend the committee amendments. (AM2241, Legislative Journal page 532.)

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Coordsen, recognized to open on your amendment.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Thank you, Mr. President, members of the body. Again, it's my belief that my amendment, in fact, provides a generally more liberal situation. The bill, as it currently exists, or the committee amendment as it currently exists, still mandates that a railroad type fence be installed where a single landowners property is divided by a state recreational trail, and then it further provides for a boundary fence; the commission shall be responsible for 100 percent of the construction or replacement costs, and the adjoining
