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requirement that was at one point used in the past.

SENATOR SCHMITT: Right.

SENATOR RAIKES: Okay. Another question, concerns...thank you, Senator Schmitt. Another question concerns line 7. It says, "The purpose of this section is to prohibit all types of ticket quota requirements for law enforcement officers." Now could a person rewrite that or does that really mean all types of ticket quota requirements for law enforcement officers are hereby prohibited? I ask a question of Senator Chambers, please.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Chambers, please yield.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Yes, I will.

SENATOR RAIKES: Senator, on page or line 7, excuse me...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Yes.

SENATOR RAIKES: ...the sentence begins with "purpose". Would your interpretation be that that, in effect, says, all types of ticket quota requirements for law enforcement officers are hereby prohibited?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: That's exactly what it says and that's what it means.

SENATOR RAIKES: Okay. So, for example, suppose that I was the supervisor over you in a law enforcement capacity.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: God forbid.

SENATOR RAIKES: I can't imagine that I could be paid enough for that job but, at any rate, let's assume that, and suppose I say to you, look, I notice that you've been giving 50 citations a month for jaywalking;...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Um-hum.

SENATOR RAIKES: ...I really think that's...that's too much of that kind of thing; I don't really think you ought to be doing
