Schrock, on the confirmation report.

SENATOR SCHROCK: Mr. Chairman, members of the Legislature, I do know Beverly Neth. She is from Red Cloud, Nebraska. Very capable individual and just wanted to say something positive about her this morning.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Schrock. Anybody else wishing to speak on the confirmation report? Seeing none, Senator Bromm, did you wish to close? Senator Bromm waives closing. The question before the body is, shall the confirmation report by the Transportation and Telecommunications Committee be adopted? All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 33 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of the confirmation report.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The confirmation report is adopted. Mr. Clerk, next agenda item.

CLERK: Mr. President, LR 295 by Senator Wickersham. (Read title.) The resolution was introduced on January 18, referred to Natural Resources for public hearing. The Natural Resource Committee has reported it back to the Legislature for further consideration.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Schrock, I believe you're going to handle this for Senator Wickersham. You're recognized.

SENATOR SCHROCK: Yes, Mr. Chairman, members of the Legislature, LR 295 is a legislative resolution heard by the Natural Resources Committee. It is for the approval of a gift of real estate located in Dawes County, from Kenneth L. Hollrah and Shirley P. Hollrah to the Game and Parks Commission, which will be maintained as an addition to the Chadron State Park for public outdoor recreation activities. The Nebraska Game and Parks Foundation is offering the state of Nebraska a gift of property adjacent to the south side entrance of Chadron State Park, in the Pine Ridge area of northwest Nebraska. This property is approximately 2.6 acres with improvement. The improvements include a small structure that is approximately
