CLERK: 27 ayes, 4 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Lynch's amendment.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The amendment is agreed to.

CLERK: Senator Lynch, I now have AM1981, but I have a note, Senator, you wish to withdraw AM1981.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Without objection? It is withdrawn.

CLERK: I have nothing further to the bill...

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Members, if I could have your attention, please. If you could please take your conversations off the floor, your colleagues would appreciate it, as would the Clerk and myself. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, thank you. Senator, I have nothing...or, Mr. President, I have nothing further pending to LB 659.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Discussion on the advancement of LB 659? Senator Lynch, recognized to close.

SENATOR LYNCH: I think we've discussed the issue very thoroughly and I hope we understand what it does and what it doesn't do, most importantly. And I respectfully ask for your support and advancement to Select File.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Lynch. The question is the advancement of LB 659. Those in favor vote aye, those opposed nay. Voting on the advancement of LB 659. Mr. Clerk, please record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 5 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of LB 659.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The bill is advanced. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 659A by Senator Lynch. (Read title.)

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Lynch, recognized to open on the A bill to LB 659.
