PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Hartnett. (Visitors introduced.) For discussion on the confirmation report of the Urban Affairs Committee, Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you, Mr. President. The first thing I will do is correct a couple of things that Senator Hartnett said. He is listening. This first gentleman's name is Carson, as in Jack Carson or Carson City, Nevada, rather than Carlson, and I can understand the mistake. Then Mr. Schweitzer's first name is Charles, rather than Clarence...I meant it's Clarence, rather than Charles, and the only reason I'm correcting it is so that if anybody looks at the transcript they'll know that the people being voted on are the ones listed here. And I have often misspoke...misspoken when giving a name, but it wouldn't be as consequential as this one, where we're actually voting on people by their name. Now I'd like to ask Senator Hartnett a question, if I may.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Senator Hartnett, this...this group deals only with these volunteer fire departments?
