They do not have built into them a mechanism that protects them from cruel adults. They don't know how to withdraw their love, like adults can do, and not have their feelings hurt again, and again, and again. So maybe you can call it evolution, maybe you can call it a change by whatever name; but since children are so helpless and abused so much by adults that they're taking the matter into their own hands and these children are doing to adults what adults have done to children for so many years. Infants are shaken to death. Teenagers are beaten to death. Young girls are raped by their own fathers. So now children are killing their parents. The parents sowed the wind and now they're reaping the whirlwind. And this is not happening in the families of black children. This is happening among the white children, the ones whom nobody can understand why this was done. They had every opportunity. They came from middle- or upper-class homes. Their families were rich. They gave them everything, and they made guns available. And when the children felt, for whatever reason, they couldn't take it anymore, they turn the gun on the parent.
