things are happening, one is they're in other levels of service that, to me, are very risky. And I have talked to people in the system who are very worried about some of the kids that are in these nonsecure placements, who may or may not have an appropriate treatment, what's happening, not only to them, themselves, but what happens to the people they are with, what could happen, what's a serious problem in those facilities? We need to have a secure facility that gets at the needs of those youth. And this is not a beautiful, perfect solution, it's sort of an ugly solution. We already have transferred it to the adult system,...

SENATOR CROSBY: One minute.

SENATOR THOMPSON: ...they are operating it, the employees there are working hard and, you know, we have people who have been together now for about a year, working together, and they've been working very, very hard to make this facility work for the population they are serving. We're going to ask for a disruption of that. But this is one of those issues that doesn't have an easy answer. Not transferring it back is going to leave a significant problem in the juvenile system. We need to address that need, and the best solution, I believe, and it's a compromise solution, if I wanted my solution, I would take the facility back totally to the juvenile system. But I realize we have significant issues with the younger kids in the adult system. I think the best answer is to go back to the original purpose of the facility, to make it a treatment facility, provide that treatment there that was always intended for it. This is a very, very expensive facility to construct. Once we restore that facility,...

SENATOR CROSBY: Time. Thank you, Senator Thompson. Senator Dwite Pedersen.

SENATOR DW. PEDERSEN: Thank you, Madam President, members of the Legislature. This is my last time to talk on this. And I won't take my full time. But I want to emphasize to you that this isn't only a bill of fiscal consequences or fiscal betterment for this county of Douglas County. This is a bill that is responsible to youth. Yes, it would save the taxpayers some money, the property taxpayers some money in Douglas County.
