PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass? Those in favor vote aye, those opposed nay. Madam Clerk, please record.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Record vote read, Legislative Journal page 622.) Vote is 41 ayes, 4 nays, 2 present and not voting, 2 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The bill is passed. (Visitors introduced.) Madam Clerk, LB 658.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LB 658 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass? Those in favor vote aye, those opposed nay. Have you voted? Mr. Clerk, please record.

CLERK: (Record vote read, Legislative Journal page 623.) 30 ayes, 17 nays, 2 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The bill is passed. (Visitors introduced.) Mr. Clerk, LB 729.

CLERK: Mr. President, a procedural matter. Senator Kristensen, I have an amendment to you, AM1741. I understand you want to withdraw, Senator.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Without objection, it is withdrawn.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LB 729 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass? Those in favor vote aye, those opposed nay. Madam Clerk, please record.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Record vote read, Legislative Journal pages 623-624.) The vote is 30 ayes, 18 nays, and 1 excused and not voting, Mr. President.
