CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Smith.

SENATOR SMITH: Mr. President, I move the advancement of LB 419 to E & R for engrossing.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Wickersham.

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: Mr. President, LB 419 is Senator Coordsen's priority bill from last session. It was debated on General File at that time and then we had some further discussion this year, earlier, concerning the bill. The primary functions of the bill as currently before you and as amended are to change various provisions for the assessment of farm sites and rural home sites that are connected with agricultural properties. I'm afraid that we have to apologize to the body a little bit. The...there...we've been in discussions with Senator Coordsen. I believe that there might actually be an amendment that he would wish to offer to this bill before your final consideration this morning. That amendment is, I believe, being prepared, but I'll let Senator Coordsen speak to that. We moved a little bit faster than what we were anticipating this morning. Well, I'm not sure. Mr. President, I would yield the balance of my time to...

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The Speaker.

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: ...to the Speaker. That's a good idea.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Wickersham. Speaker Kristensen.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Thank you, Mr. President, members of the Legislature. Mr. President, given the fact of what Senator Wickersham said, instead of taking the time here while they do the amendment, I would move and remove from the agenda right now LB 419 and ask that it be placed at the bottom, and will do so now, place it at the bottom of Select File this morning, give them time to do that amendment. I move to...
