SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: ...of the tree, you know?

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: My purpose isn't...is just, if for nothing else, to satisfy myself. I'm not objecting to it, because I don't know. It's on Select File. I would tend to agree with you that if it's punitive you ought to take it out because you can't enforce it anyway, but I think there is another provision somewhere. I'll look at it between now and Final Reading and...I was just if you knew...

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay. If I'm missing a distinction, I'd be glad to take it off.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Okay. Thank you.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Beutler, you're recognized to close.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Waive closing.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Beutler waives closing. The question is the adoption of the amendment, AM2129, to LB 626. Those in favor vote aye, those opposed nay. Mr. Clerk, please record.
