CLERK: LB 204, Senator Smith, I have Enrollment and Review amendments. (AM7187, Legislative Journal page 595.)

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Smith.

SENATOR SMITH: Mr. President, I move the adoption of the E & R amendments to LB 204.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Question is the adoption of the E & R amendments to LB 204. Those in favor say aye. Those opposed nay. They are agreed to.

CLERK: I have nothing further on LB 204, Senator.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Smith.

SENATOR SMITH: Mr. President, I move the advancement of LB 204 to E & R for engrossing.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Question is the advancement of LB 204 to E & R for engrossment. Those in favor say aye. Those opposed nay. The bill is advanced. Mr. Clerk.
