

TRANSCRIPT PREPARED BY THE CLERK OF THE LEGISLATURE
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February 11, 2000 LB 1004

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Matzke. Senator Engel, on the committee amendments.

SENATOR ENGEL: Mr. Chairman, members, I agree with Senator Matzke, and I appreciate Senator Chambers' diligence in helping make this a better bill. We've worked together before making bills better. We've worked...and we've worked apart and we've both prevailed. So I think, since this is such an important bill, that I'm more than willing to make it as perfect as we can. So I appreciate that, and thank you very much.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Engel. There are no further lights on. Senator Jones, did you wish to close on the committee amendments? Senator Jones waives closing. The question before the body is, shall the committee amendments be adopted to LB 1004? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. We're voting on the committee amendments to LB 1004. Have you all voted who care to? Record, please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 29 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of the committee amendments.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The committee amendments are adopted. We are now on the advancement to E & R Initial of LB 1004. Is there any further discussion? Senator Engel, you're recognized for discussion.

SENATOR ENGEL: I'd just appreciate your advancing the bill to Select File and we'll try to work out these differences between now and then. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Engel. Any further discussion? Senator Engel, did you wish to close? Senator Engel waives closing. The question before the body is, shall LB 1004 be advanced to E & R Initial? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted who care to? Record, please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 34 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of LB 1004.

SENATOR CUDABACK: LB 1004 does advance to E & R Initial.
