vision that Senator Brown talked about, if there's going to be a vision as to how this money should be used. And, secondly, I know there was some discussion as to whether that vision would be broad in the sense of covering the whole healthcare area, or whether it would be directed more towards what we call, in a somewhat vague sense, I suppose, a public health system? That is, towards programs that are highly preventative in nature and have a high level of accessibility. At least I take it that those are two of the characteristics of what we would call a public health program. And I'd also be interested in your discussion of...of what a public health program is, in and of itself, to the extent that it is a term of art. I'm not fully acquainted with how that...how those terms are used. And then...so who gives the vision, what's their directive in terms of what kind of a vision it's supposed to be, and who will execute it?

SENATOR CUDABACK: Would you respond, Senator Jensen?

SENATOR BEUTLER: I assume that bottom line is, with respect...as with respect to all ongoing programs, this Legislature, one way or another, would be approving whatever...whatever real elements are ultimately put into this...into this vision. So those...those three questions, to the extent that you are able to elaborate.

SENATOR JENSEN: Okay, Mr. President, members of the body, I'll try to respond. The council, made up of six individuals, have had several meetings this last year. One of the first ones that they did have was with the Health and Human Services Committee and then with the members of the Excellence in Health Care Council. We told them, or related to them, what we, as committee, felt the purpose was. They have sat down and they have established their rules and regulation. They have also set some priorities for which that they would like to proceed. Now theirs is a grant process and whether...and, Senator, your bill that you had, which set out some of those guidelines, they've also been working on how they should proceed and they are trying to set some priorities and...but they're...they are an independent, at this point in time, an independent body and will make decisions as to the grant.
