control, that particular kind of control is not embraced in the prohibition in the green copy. Now to say it in laymen's terminology. When a manufacturer authorizes a dealership, there is communication, there are transactions back and forth between the dealer and the manufacturer which are perfectly proper and of concern to nobody, but those communications and those transactions do have an influence on what the franchisee or dealer will do. Senator Bromm's amendment is designed to make it clear that in that realm of appropriate interrelationship between the dealer and the manufacturer the word "control" as used in this statute does not apply there. I would recommend that we adopt this language that Senator Bromm is offering. Then we can read it in context with what the green copy would offer, show that it is necessary, and then that will leave for our more detailed analysis and discussion the part of Senator Bromm's amendment that deals with transactions outside of Nebraska for the sale and purchase of a vehicle when the vehicle is to be delivered in Nebraska. I said all that to say this: I support...

SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.
