So it is tied into the franchise agreement and that's why in another...in another portion of the bill we have those provisions that a manufacturer couldn't come in and across the street...if I spent the money for a franchise agreement, did all the things I got to do to get a franchise, built my building just right and all that, they couldn't come across the street and put up an authorized service center from Ford Motor Company and basically run my shop out of business or make it very difficult for me to survive after having spent the money for that franchise. SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay. So in...in every case, the warranty work is tied into the franchise agreement?
