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homes aren't movable, so we don't worry about that, and we have a substantial body of law that protects them. But motor vehicles would probably be the next highest family investment and, to me, the ability to access the Nebraska system of consumer protection and our court system to resolve disputes to make sure that the money you invest you get what you paid for as it relates to a new vehicle is really important to me. And that's the reason I can do it, I can start with the more expensive items and legislate in that area. And the little things, like my phone card, that's what I get for dealing on the Internet. That's what I get for dealing with somebody who I don't know. And I can afford to learn a \$20 lesson. I can't afford to learn a \$20,000 lesson. And most people who go out and buy a motor vehicle are going to shop. They're going to shop extensively. If they can have some savings, they want to realize it. That's the reason also I think with this bill it's important that there be some disclosure that who delivery is made to is they're not going to take the place of the manufacturer. They're not going to be able to come in and do the repair work and still keep your warranty. I don't want those people to be blindsided. And so I know that we're working on the amendment. I think th's first portion, as I understand it, Senator Bromm, is fairly agreed upon. Is that generally...? Then it makes no sense to go on and talk about this portion. I think we ought to adopt it. I'd be happy to talk about other parts, as I understand it, but I would yield my time back, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Kristensen. There are no further lights on. Senator Bromm, did you wish to close on the first part of the divided question to LB 1018?

SENATOR BROMM: Thank you, Senator Cudaback. Only to remind the body that we're dealing with the portion of the bill on page 12, line 17 and it's the lines 1 through 4 of AM2348. I think everyone that's spoken agrees with the amendment. Senator Chambers, in his initial comments on this portion of the amendment, said that he agreed with the amendment, I believe, so I just ask the body to adopt this portion.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Bromm. The question before the body is, shall part one of the divided amendment,
