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a fair amount of work to set that up. I think it could be done if that were the choice or the policy decision. I think one of the reasons that it hasn't happened and, again, this is simply a personal opinion, but my dad was a farmer, my brother is a farmer, most of my cousins are farmers, my uncles are farmers, and they're an independent lot, and the equipment dealers are very much the same way. They are a very independent lot and they don't...they aren't going to want to, unless they absolutely have to, to survive, subject themselves to the licensing and regulation that automobile dealers have subjected themselves to or that we have, as policymakers, agreed to subject them to, and I think that's part of the reason there's a difference at this point. Should there be a policy change in the future I'd be more than willing to talk about that, but I think that's why we're where we are today. With respect to this...with respect to this portion of the amendment, this portion of the amendment amends page 15, line 23. It is...it is, I think, an improvement in the language of that section of the bill. There are other changes to that section of the bill that I think we'll want to make and I've had an amendment drafted already to talk about, but this section talks about identifying a delivery...a sale that does not take place in Nebraska but provides for delivery in Nebraska and subjecting that to the terms of this bill, so that is the primary thrust of this amendment. Thank you, Senator Cudaback.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Bromm. Senator Chambers, on part two of the divided question.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you, Mr. President. Senator Bromm, I would like to ask you a question.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Bromm, do you yield to a question?

SENATOR BROMM: Yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Would the amendment that you just showed me that we had discussed go to this portion of your amendment, or go to the bill after we've adopted this second portion?
