SENATOR CHAMBERS: So if Senator Beutler, selling cars by way of the Internet, now he probably wouldn't want to get a dealer's license in every state in the country, but if there were laws such as this and that person obtained a Nebraska's...a Nebraska dealer's license, how would this language impact on that Massachusetts dealer who has a Nebraska dealer's license but he himself is not going to come to Nebraska and make the delivery? We're not talking about whether he is licensed or not but where the transaction occurs regardless of whether he's licensed as a Nebraska dealer or not, isn't that true? That's my question. Having a dealer's...a Nebraska dealer's license, if he or she is going to sell cars from another state that would not exempt him or her from the operation of this law if the car still is going to be delivered in Nebraska after the transaction took place in another state.

SENATOR BROMM: I think I...I believe that's correct and if he had a Nebraska dealer's license, if something, if there was a complaint, the complaint could be made to our licensing board and he could be subjected to a fine or whatever penalty under our licensing board that might apply, if he had a Nebraska dealer's license.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay. And I don't want to go into that too deeply. I just wanted to clarify that point and I probably muddied the water with all that preliminary. But what I think we ought to focus on with this language are two things: the transaction takes place in another state; the vehicle is to be delivered in Nebraska. Now, based on that, I have another question to ask Senator Bromm. Senator Bromm, if the vehicle is located in Nebraska would this law apply, the vehicle that is to be sold? Let's say Senator Beutler does all of his...

SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...work in Massachusetts and has something worked out in the state of Nebraska. Would...realistically, if that car that Senator Beutler was going to sell you in Nebraska was on the lot of a Nebraska dealer then that would take care of this because that dealer would probably be the one to pass it on to you.
