SENATOR BEUTLER: Another franchise holder.

SENATOR BROMM: I think they would be. I think...

SENATOR CUDABACK: Time. Thank you, Senator Beutler. Is there anybody else wishing to speak on part two of the divided amendment? Seeing no further lights on, Senator Bromm, did you wish to close on part two of AM2348?

SENATOR BROMM: Thank you, Senator Cudaback, and I...I think after we deal with this amendment we'll get back to Senator Beutler's discussion and questions with regard to a different section of the bill and try to...try to answer that. But this...this portion of the amendment, again, just deals with page 15, line 23, striking "requires or allows", puts in some language which I think clarifies, better describes what we're doing, and on page 17, line 5, inserts "an existing" for the word "a". I don't think there's strong objection or objection I've heard with respect to this particular portion of the amendment, so I'd ask for its adoption.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Bromm. The question before the body is, shall part two of the divided amendment, AM2348, be adopted to LB 1018? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted who care to? Record, please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Bromm's amendment.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Part two of the divided amendment is adopted to LB 1018. We are now on discussion of the bill itself. Senator Chambers. This is for the advancement of E & R Initial.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, because we don't have a number of amendments up there, I am going to have to offer some amendments to the bill in order to discuss the bill. I couldn't possibly say all that I want to say on this in three times...I meant during three times to speak. When I'm offering an amendment that I am very serious about I'll make that clear.
