Legislature. Senator Bromm, we changed this section now a couple of times. Could you do me a favor and just read, taking into account what your first amendment was, what the first two sentences would be there of new language on page 15, so that would be lines 22 down. Because we've stricken now, this will be the second attempt of striking things out. Could you just read that for me as you think it sets today, given, if we adopt this amendment.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Would you respond, Senator Chambers (sic).

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Bromm.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: If, oh...

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: They look similar, but they're...

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Bromm, excuse me.

SENATOR BROMM: Yes, yes. Senator Kristensen, starting on line 22, page 15, is that...

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Yes.

SENATOR BROMM: Okay. I'll go ahead and try to read as I'm looking at the amendments. "If a transaction for the sale of a new motor vehicle which does not take place in the state of Nebraska provides for delivery in Nebraska, delivery in Nebraska shall only be made by a motor vehicle dealer licensed and bonded in Nebraska." Okay, that's the first sentence.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Yes.

SENATOR BROMM: Then with this proposed amendment, continuing, "The motor vehicle dealer shall be jointly and severally liable for compliance with all applicable laws and contracts with the seller." And then strike the language down through "contracts", on line 28.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Okay.

SENATOR BROMM: And then continuing, "If the dealer is not a
