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So that is...they are subject to the same type of leases, in my opinion, from what I've gathered, as car dealerships are. And the point of, when we were talking about the sales tax, it is not necessarily at the point where you register that vehicle. But if you live in a town outside of the county seat, you pay the sales tax rate of your community. If you have an extra sales tax in your community, then you are subject to that, not in the town where the county seat is at. You are subject to your local. If the county seat has an extra half cent sales tax within that city, and you live outside of that city, you aren't charged that. It's...the sales tax is figured at your place of residence. I just wanted to make that...make that clear and give you a little input on how lease agreements are made in other areas such as the fast food operations. With that, I'll turn the rest of my time back to the Chair. Thank you.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Janssen. Senator Chambers, you're recognized to close on your amendment.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President, the only reason I will close is to take a minute or two to touch on another item that I'm going to work on, and I'm talking to Senator Kristensen about it now, that relates to this idea found on page 12, in line 20, where the language says, among other things, this manufacturer shall not own an interest in a franchise. And I was wondering if it would be appropriate to specify that we're talking about a legal interest and not just one of those, as Senator Kristensen gave me as an example, where you're interested in your neighbor not going bankrupt in order that he or she would be in a position to maintain the appearance of the house, maintain the yard and things such as that. But that would not be a legal interest in the property of the neighbor. So if it is...if it turns out to be agreed that just the term "interest" is not ambiguous, then I will not offer anything by way of amendment. But these are the types of things that I'm looking at. So I will just accept the vote on this one, since Senator Bromm and others have expressed agreement with adopting this one that is pending now.
