SENATOR BEUTLER: Yes.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Okay.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Yes.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: And at some point in time I assume that this...I'm not, you know, this morning I think there are other things to visit about. I'd be a little leery of the words "such service" just because I'm...I'd be more clear with that and talk about delivery charge. I won't do it now, let's...what I would do is I think everybody is in favor of the concept. Let's...we'll...we'll look at that as we go forward. But as long as I've got some intent that you're talking about delivery charge and not warranty service, I'm fine. Thank you, Mr. President.

SENATOR BEUTLER: I think, through the conversation of the several people that have spoken, that the intent of the amendment is clear and pretty much agreed upon. So I would ask the support of the body. Thank you.
