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agreement...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Yes.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: ...and if...if the reposessor can't use the entity for himself or herself or itself, it can only hold it for resale. I'm trying to articulate it the best I can, but basically...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: I'm following.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: ...when you take that agreement away from them, you just can't make up a default so you can gain ownership...

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: One minute.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: ...interest of the franchise. What you have to do is put it up for sale and sell it to someone else, and you can't use that as a back door to own it.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: But we don't do that with reference to farms,...

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: No.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...commercial property, farm implements, fast food franchises, or any other area of commercial activity, do we?

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Unless you have a contract, and that's where I guess...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Right, the contract governs it, but where we put into the law that this must be sold for a reasonable price.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Oh, I would agree, I would agree, right. I don't think we've done that other...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Are you comfortable putting that in the law?

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Comfortable, comfortable is...
