SENATOR BEUTLER: ...and the provisions of this act.

SENATOR BROMM: That's right.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay. One of the provisions of 60-1400 et seq. is what's called a special permit section. And it says that sales by a franchisee, in I think all cases, are limited to his established place of business, unless he gets a special permit for each and every occasion where he sells from other than his established place of business. If you're selling by Internet, is that sale at the established place of business, or does he need to get a special permit?

SENATOR BROMM: It has been, Senator Beutler, and that's a very good question. It has been the interpretation of the industry and of the licensing board that that is a sale at his place of business where he is licensed. The situation that that statute refers to that's been interpreted to apply is, for example, if that...if that dealer in Falls City or somewhere decides to set up a booth at the State Fair to show automobiles and perhaps sell automobiles at the State Fair, they would then apply for that special permit to sell those automobiles at a remote location. But many...I think many dealers, in fact I saw the percentage, it was like 74 percent of the dealers in the state have a web site and are offering to sell cars on that web site, but it's been interpreted or understood that that is a sale that's occurring at the place of the web site, which is their dealership.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay, so if they had the...if they had the...if they had...if they operated out of their home, instead of the dealership, then it wouldn't be?

SENATOR BROMM: That is a good question. If the...I...I don't know that it would matter where the origin of the web site was as much as the information on...on...on the net, if the net referred to the cars being available at the dealership address and to contact the dealership...

SENATOR BEUTLER: The net is nowhere.

SENATOR BROMM: Pardon me?
