so I asked, I introduced the amendment, to change it back to General Fund funding and then we worked out a compromise with the Governor to look at some federal funding in addition to that. I just ask you please understand the value of the legislation, but think very carefully about what you're going to do as the amendments are offered. I am a co-introducer with Senator Jensen of his amendment and will speak to that later.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: One minute.

SENATOR BYARS: That will...that will allow us to fund this piece of legislation.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Byars. Senator Bohlke, you're recognized to close on the committee amendments to LB 1436.

SENATOR BOHLKE: Thank you, Mr. President, I'm sorry. I would just remind everyone that we are on the committee amendments. I've explained what the committee amendments do. They enlarge the committee, make sure...reiterate that it is...can be a statewide campaign, and I think there's general agreement with everyone here, including Senator Jensen, I don't think anyone has spoke against the committee amendments, and so I would hope we could proceed and adopt the committee amendments at this time. Thank you.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Bohlke. The question is the adoption of the committee amendments to LB 1436. Those in favor vote aye, those opposed nay. Voting on the adoption of the committee amendments. Mr. Clerk, please record.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of committee amendments.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The committee amendments are adopted. (Visitors introduced.) Mr. Clerk.
