SENATOR HUDKINS: Absolutely, it would be under the lid levy limitations. And I don't know the rest of your question, what was it?

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: And it simply clarifies what many of us would already read into the law, the one sentence clarifies that it can be used for real property to comprise all fairgrounds. So...

SENATOR HUDKINS: That's all it does.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: So it's primarily a clarification of what many would think is already there, and it still falls under the lid limit.

SENATOR HUDKINS: Yes.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Okay, thank you.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Wehrbein. Senator Schimek, would you like to close on the committee amendments? Senator Janssen, would you like to close on the committee amendments, as Vice Chair?

SENATOR JANSSEN: I'd just waive...waive closing.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Closing is waived. The question is the adoption of the committee amendments to LB 1190. Those in favor vote aye, those opposed nay. Mr. Clerk, please record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of committee amendments.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Committee amendments are adopted. Debate on advancement of LB 1190, Senator Janssen.

SENATOR JANSSEN: Thank you, Mr. Lieutenant Governor, members of the Legislature. I might bring to the attention of the body that this...this bill has the word "may" in it. It is still up to the discretion of the county boards to allow the ag societies to do this particular action that they are asking for. Nowhere
