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through the emergency manager's budget. So it wasn't like the counties were or are ignoring the issue. It is just that the counties have also been put under some spending limits that we did and there isn't a whole lot of extra room in their budgets for additional things. And part of the responsibility of that comes back to the Legislature in trying to address property tax.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Well, I definitely believe that's true. I am just wanting from this point forward to those counties that don't have it, they are going to do that in good faith also, use that...I mean that's the intent?

SENATOR PREISTER: Yes, Senator Wehrbein, that is...

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: That's all I wanted to have comment on. Thank you.

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you. Thank you, Senator Wehrbein. Senator Preister, your light is next.

SENATOR PREISTER: Thank you, Honorable President, friends all. I appreciate again Senator Wehrbein's questions, in particular, because I think these are important questions. Many of them we worked on over the interim in various subgroups of the various committees that we had together. There were mailings that went out to businesses, to responders, to all of the folks that we could identify who are interested in this concern that many of us have that frequently is ignored, and we really haven't done a whole lot with. I want to reiterate on the committee amendments that this is temporary. I have no intention at this time of coming back for additional General Fund monies. I appreciate the issue that Senator Beutler raises about having the people who make money from the hazardous materials being assessed a fee and that fee paying for the planning. I view and view that as a good insurance policy. To me that was establishing insurance, so that if something happened, it would minimize loss of life or personal injury. It would minimize property damage. I view this as a minimal insurance policy for those businesses. They had other concerns and very legitimate concerns that they brought to the table in the discussions. I guess I would have to say when you bring all the players together, when you have everybody come and bring their opinions together, that's the
