SENATOR Dw. PEDERSEN: That would be set by the...my understanding, that would be set by the school where they're going.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay, so that's not the tuition and fees we're talking about.

SENATOR Dw. PEDERSEN: No.

SENATOR BEUTLER: So whatever school is out there, they charge their tuition and fees for their portion of it, and then for the academy portion the council then would set tuition and fees for that portion that are sufficient to take care of all of the costs of the academy. Is that the way it's designed to work?

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay. And then with regard to continuing education, is that going to take place in the other schools that are certified, or is that taking place in the academy?

SENATOR BEUTLER: As it does now. They're currently authorized to require continuing education courses?

SENATOR Dw. PEDERSEN: Are they authorized?

SENATOR BEUTLER: Or who is currently authorized to require continuing education courses?
