next survey and I think we will get much better information the next time around. I think we've accomplished several things here with this particular activity this year. First of all, we found out there's a number of boards and commissions that we didn't even really know existed. Secondly, we have found contact people for most of them now. Thirdly, I think that we've made it clear to the different boards and commissions that this is something that we were authorized by statute to do and we need their cooperation and their response. And then, fourthly, probably the last thing we accomplished is that we have 19 boards and commissions here that I think we could safely sunset. There may be others. We would certainly be willing to listen to any other ideas that this body might have and, in fact, I think Senator Brown is probably going to speak to an issue that she has been working on with Health and Human Services Committee. With that, I have given you a handout which lists all the boards and commissions and, for the record, I will just go over them briefly. There's the Bessey Memorial Fund Commission, the Building Energy Conservation Standards Board, the Capitol Murals Commission, the Commission on Information Technology, the Committee on Continuing Pharmacy Education, the Gaming Commission, the Highway Bond Commission, the Laboratory Advisory Board, Marriage and Family Therapy Committee, Nebraska Commission on Intergovernmental Cooperation, the Nebraska Education Council, the Nebraska Pesticide Board, the Nebraskaplex Commission, the Professional Counseling Committee, the Review Incentives Program Committee, Social Work Committee, Task Force to Study Service Delivery for Mental Illness and Substance Abuse, Title XXI Committee,...

One final thing I would like to say is I think we would do ourselves all a favor if every time we establish a new committee or task force or commission that we put a sunset clause on that particular entity, and, Senator Dierks, I was just noticing on the last bill there is no sunset clause. I think that if we did that in a consistent manner then, in a consistent manner, we would have to look at those committees, boards, and commissions and they
