SENATOR SCHIMEK: One minute.

SENATOR BROMM: ...that that...that that was the right thing to do. On the other end of the spectrum, 18 to 21, there was less discussion, less of a case made, and I'm not sure, quite frankly, what the options are there and that's an area that I would like to look at. I don't know if it's more cost-effective for that to fall into the Health and Human Services arena versus the educational arena or not, but I'd certainly, for one, be willing to look at...at the...at the ramifications of that, and so I will support the Bohlke amendment to the amendment and the bill, based on the discussion I've heard. Thank you, Senator Schimek.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Thank you, Senator Bromm. Senator Bohlke, there are no further lights. Would you wish to close on your amendment to the amendment?

SENATOR BOHLKE: Yes, Madam President and members. This is the amendment to the amendment, and what this does is takes out the portion that I talked about before that would have had the joint recommendation from the Education Department and Department of Health and Human Services for the cost of state wards, it removes that from the bill.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Thank you, Senator Bohlke. The question is the adoption of the Bohlke amendment to the committee amendments. All in favor vote aye; all opposed vote nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 37 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the adoption of Senator Bohlke's amendment to the committee amendments.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. We are now back to the committee amendments and we will have discussion on the committee amendments. Seeing no lights, Senator Bohlke, would you wish to close on the committee amendment?

SENATOR BOHLKE: Madam President and members, this removes the legal fees that we discussed before and then leaves in the bill
