PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: One minute.

SENATOR JANSSEN: With that, I'll just leave you make up your own minds what you think about the bracket motion, but I would urge you not to support Senator Jensen's bracket motion. Thank you.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Janssen. On the bracket motion to LB 659, Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I can understand Senator Jensen's concern and his general opposition to gambling, which is a concern that I share. But the fact that the Attorney General would be invited into this discussion at a time when he's running for U.S. Senate could very easily convert it into something that he would use for political purposes, as he has done other issues on many occasions. This is an issue which the Legislature can handle. If you agree with Senator Lynch's bill, you'll vote for it. If you are like Senator Jensen and I, in our general opposition to gambling, you'll vote against it. But I would not like to see this bill given to the Attorney General so that he will write not a legal opinion but a political diatribe, whichever way he thinks the wind is blowing and will give him the most political mileage that is the way the decision will be reached by him and the kind of so-called Opinion that will be delivered. I could show you Opinion after Opinion, as it's called, which he has written which is not on the issue at all. As a matter of fact,
